#### **NEBRASKA**

At Auburn, the spirit of philanthropy shines through in community partnerships that bring people of all ages together for the greater good. In 2024, Future Farmers of America students from Auburn High School not only spent time planting succulents with residents, they also learned the importance of engaging with the community and explored career opportunities in long-term care.



#### **SOUTH DAKOTA**

Volunteerism highlights the essence of philanthropy at Lakota, located 63 miles west of Grand Forks. Here, local volunteers like 12-year-old Peyton Marquart are giving of their time and talents to bring patients and residents together to foster connections and build community.

Depending on the day, Peyton will spend time playing games with residents or entertaining them with cartwheels. She'll also bring goats from her family farm to visit.

"When they see her bringing the goats or when they see her smile, they really light up," said Lakota Administrator Anna Halvorson.



three daughters. And, most recently, the blessing of compassionate care from the Inpatient Rehabilitation unit at Good Samaritan - Ottumwa.

"I'd been in the hospital and went to the Inpatient Rehabilitation unit for ongoing recovery," Kjer said. "I was there for about two months and was just overwhelmed by the care I received. Not just medically, but from a spiritual perspective as well. Everyone was outstanding, from the food service staff to the physical and occupational therapists, to the nursing staff and CNAs. They were all so motivating and uplifting. They helped me, at age 72, remember what's important in life. They reminded me the good Lord gave me a life to live, so I'd better live it."

To express his gratitude for the care he received, and to celebrate the life and legacy of his beloved wife, who passed away in 2023, Kjer made a \$50,000 gift to the Good Samaritan Foundation to benefit residents and families

"I wanted to do something meaningful while I was alive," Kjer said. "I don't know what the good Lord has in store for my future, but for now, I have the satisfaction and joy that comes from thanking these people and recognizing the good that's happening here — all in memory of my loving wife."
